The 4 Paris'schools of design , Ecole Boule, Ecole Duperre Ecole Estienne, and Ensaama have built up a common International Programme for foreign students.

All participants are selected on the basis of their academic records, CVs and portfolios and thus given the possibility to spend a study period in these institutions.

Besides the usual courses corresponding to the respective specificities of each of the 4 schools in line with the students' project, several modules are offered :

French, art history, the cultural discovery of Paris, life drawing, modelling, etc. Other courses can be organized according to the needs.

NB : A study period in the International Programme can vary from 3 to 12 months, and the courses will be offered according to the students'needs, level and personal project. At the end of the study period, a certificate will be delivered, stating the courses attended, the number of tuition hours, and the grades obtained by the students in each course.

Foreign students applying for a study period in Duperré within the International Programme must fulfill the following conditions :

1. On application, students must send :

- A CV ;
- A letter of short description of the candidate's professional or research project ;
- Evidence of diplomas or degrees obtained with details of courses and grades ;
- A personal portfolio containing color photocopies of work or a CD motivation stating the student's reasons for choosing the institution, the course, the study level.

NB : Documents should be written or translated in French or English, and shall not be returned.

- Application deadline for following fall semester : end of May ;
- Application deadline for following spring semester : end of September ;
- Applications will be examined by the jury, and decision shall be notified to the candidates by the end of June (fall sem.), and end of Octobre (spring sem.)

2. Before registration,students will submit to a French language test to check their fluency (all courses are given in French)

- > The following documents must be provided :
 - A Social Security or Health Insurance contract ;
 - A personal Insurance contract covering «civil risks» ;
 - Evidence of a permanent address in France (rent contract or lodging certificate).
- > Students coming from countries outside the European Community must also provide :
 - Evidence of sufficient and regular financial support or income (min. 438 euros / month) ;
 - A long-term visa or « carte de séjour».

NB : An appointment with the International Relations Officer must be made prior to arrival in France
